TOURNAMENT RULES

- **20,000 tournament chips.**
- **Levels will last 20 minutes.**
- This is a bounty event. A player will receive two (2) \$25 green chips for every player they eliminate.
- A single ante will be paid from the big blind for each hand. The ante is paid after the big blind. The ante will not reduce.
- On-site registration and re-entries are available until the start of Level 12 of this event at approximately 9:15PM.
- An eliminated player may re-enter the event. Alternates and late sign-ups will enter the tournament with a full chip stack and no obligation from it.
- Seating may be limited for this event.
- TDA rules apply. Tournament Director's decisions are final.
- Management reserves the right to alter, change, or cancel this tournament. Management will not be held responsible in the event of typographical errors or misinformation on the website or printed material pertaining to this event.
- Redraw at 27 and 9 players, or at Tournament Director's discretion.
- 12.5% of total teams will be "In The Money."
- Winners will be paid in casino chips.
- All tax laws, foreign and domestic, apply. Winners must show a valid ID to collect winnings. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding. Pursuant to new IRS regulations, W-2G or 1042 forms will be issued for all tournament winnings of \$5,000 or more (net of buy-in amount).
- \$150 will go towards the prize pool. \$50 will go towards the player bounty. \$50 will go towards the administrative fee, which includes all staffing/dealer fees and rake.
